Week 14 Monday	Letter Jj + Phonics Sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chant: "J says /j/ – like ज" Air Tracing: Big and small "J" using index finger in air Sand Tray Tracing: Trace Jj in salt/sand trays Flashcard Drill: Show jug, jam, jellyfish, jeep Say: "j-j-jug" while pointing 	Sand/salt trays, Jj flashcards, phonics sound chart	The Journey of the Bird and the Worm – Story Intro	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate the story using puppets/toys of bird and worm. Emphasize bird flies above, worm crawls below. Act out with students roleplaying as bird/worm. Ask: "Where is the bird?" "Where is the worm?" Show big chart: bird above tree, worm below soil. Recap with finger movement (fly high, crawl low). 	Bird and worm puppets, tree chart, floor mat, puppet stage area	Introduction to Ben's Neighbourhood	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin with the story "Ben's Neighbourhood" where Ben meets different community helpers. Introduce helpers: doctor, teacher, policeman, postman, and firefighter using puppets or toys. Use visual flashcards showing each helper and their tools. Let children identify which helper they have seen before in real life. Discuss: "Who helps us when we are sick?" or "Who teaches us in school?" Sing a helper-themed rhyme like "Community Helpers, Yes We Can!" 	Storybook on Ben's Neighbourhood, community helper flashcards, puppets/toys	Story-Based Introduction of य, र, ल, व	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce each letter with sound and short story (e.g., य – यात्री, र – रसगुल्ला, ल – लड्डू, व – वृक्ष) Demonstrate phonics for य, र, ल, व using echo repetition Air tracing for each letter with big arm movements Show related flashcards with pictures and names Children repeat letter sounds together Discuss real-life objects starting with each letter 	Flashcards with images, sand tray, story props
Week 14 Tuesday	Poem Time: Pat-a-Cake	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recite with clapping and rhythm Use gestures for pat, roll, bake Role play in pairs with pretend baking Ask: "Who do we bake for at home?" Connect rhyme to kindness and sharing 	Poem chart, playdough, props (rolling pin, bowl)	Visuals & Object Sorting – Above/Below	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show flashcards: e.g., kite above, stone below. Use classroom items like books on table (above), under chair (below). Sorting activity: sun/cloud vs. roots/rocks. Ask children to point and describe object positions. Chart work: paste "above" and "below" items. Match object cards to correct position words. 	Flashcards, classroom items, sorting sheet, object cutouts, glue stick	Role Play: Who Helps Me?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Start with a recap of Monday's story and flashcards. Assign roles: doctor, teacher, police officer, etc., and give each child a turn to role-play. Children wear basic props (e.g., paper stethoscope, badge). Practice simple dialogues like "I am a doctor. I help you feel better." Let children guess which helper their friend is acting as. End with a reflection: "How does it feel to help someone?" Week 14 Wednesday	Worksheet + J for Jam Craft	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Worksheet: Alphabets Ff–Jj – Tracing of Jj Review Ff to Jj before focusing on Jj Craft: Jam jar paper cutout Fill with red tissue or fingerprint paint Label: "J is for Jam" 	Worksheet printout, glue, red paper, paints, jam jar outline	Role Play & Object Hunt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set up bench role play: child stands above, sits below. Use real objects like bag under table, pen on book. Ask children to find objects above/below around room. "Guess where?" game with hidden toys. Review with a puppet quiz: "Where is my worm?" Movement: hands stretch up for bird, down for worm. 	Bench/stool, bags, classroom toys, puppet, flashcards	Tools and Vehicles of Helpers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show flashcards or real items (toy ambulance, hose, chalk, etc.) used by helpers. Play a matching game: Match the helper with their tool or vehicle. Use a worksheet with images to draw lines between helpers and their tools. Discuss safety items (e.g., firefighter's helmet) and their purpose. Ask: "Can a policeman write with chalk like a teacher?" – Build logic. Watch a short animated video showing each helper at work. 	Flashcards, toy tools/vehicles, matching worksheet, short video	Letter Hunt & Matching Game	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Place flashcards of य, र, ल, व around class for letter hunt Match uppercase letters to picture cards Play "Find the missing letter" with word cards Group activity: clap for correct letter sound Identify letters in poem lines Quick quiz: show picture, children say starting letter 	Letter flashcards, picture cards, word cards
