Week 17 Monday	Rhyme Introduction & Recital	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce Little Bo Peep with expressive actions Use stick puppets or finger puppets Children repeat after teacher with rhythm Clap on rhyming words: Peep–sleep, behind–kind Show rhyme on board/chart for visual cue Ask: "What do you think happened to the sheep?" 	Rhyme chart, puppets, finger puppets, audio of rhyme	Count and Match (21–25)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide objects (blocks, crayons) for students to count up to 25. Use number cards 21–25 and ask children to match them with object groups. Play "Show me 23" using flashcards and items. Recite rhyme while matching: "21, 22, count with me..." Children complete dot matching cards. Display chart of numbers 21–25 with pictures. 	Crayons, blocks, number flashcards, dot cards, chart paper, stickers	Introduction to Helpers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show flashcards of community helpers (doctor, teacher, postman, cleaner, etc.) Ask children to name and describe each helper Sing a rhyme introducing all helpers Storytime: "Who Helps Whom?" Discuss "Who helps us at home?" Matching game: helper and their work tool 	Flashcards, props (toy tools), community helpers rhyme chart, picture book	Story-Based Letter Introduction – क, ख, ग, घ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate "नेहा का बगीचा" with big picture flashcards Identify क, ख, ग, घ words in story (कली, खीरा, गुलाब, घास) Air tracing of each letter with pronunciation Sand tray tracing for tactile learning Show related picture cards for each letter Group discussion: "What plants do you like?" Week 17 Tuesday	Vocabulary & Rhyming Sounds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flashcards: sheep, crook, field, sleep, kind Children repeat the word, then match it to the rhyme line Rhyming Pairs Game: Match picture cards with rhyming pairs Tap when you hear a rhyme – builds auditory skills Draw or color Bo Peep and her sheep 	Flashcards, rhyming word picture cards, crayons	Count and Match (26–30)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continue object counting from 26–30. Group activity: children count beads and match to correct number. Play "Find the Number" game with 26–30 cards. Ask: "Who has 28 apples?" Match to number card. Draw and color groups of 29 items. Match picture cards to numbers on wall chart. 	Beads, flashcards 26–30, number wall chart, crayons, object cards	Doctor and Nurse	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Picture talk: What do doctors and nurses do? Role-play with toy stethoscope and mask Visit the hospital corner setup Draw and color a doctor's coat Craft: Make a doctor badge Teach hygiene tips from doctors (wash hands, cover mouth) 	Toy doctor set, white coats, drawing sheets, glue, crayons	Visual & Phonetic Recognition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Revise letters using image-word flashcards (क – कबूतर, ख – खरगोश, ग – गाड़ी, घ – घंटी) Match letter cards to pictures Practice phonetic sounds aloud Play "Find the Letter" on wall chart Peer activity: say one word starting with each letter Quick oral quiz on letter sounds 	Flashcards, wall chart, object cut-outs
Week 17 Wednesday	Role Play & Sheep Hunt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assign one child as Bo Peep; others as sheep "Where's the Sheep?" hide-and-peek game with toy sheep Children follow Bo Peep in a line as she searches Use clues like "Look behind the box!" to build memory Discuss: "Why did Bo Peep lose her sheep?" 	Toy sheep, blindfold (optional), classroom props	Before, After, Between (21–25)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create number line on floor from 21–30. Ask: "What comes before 23? After 22?" Play "Hop to the number after 24". Storytime: "Lisa had 25 balloons, 1 flew away. What comes before?" Arrange number cards in sequence. Practice tracing and filling blanks (21–25). 	Floor number line, flashcards, story props, tracing sheets	Policeman and Postman	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flashcards: Police, post office, tools (cap, letter bag) Story: "The Lost Letter" featuring a postman and a police officer Letter-sorting game (pretend mail delivery) Role-play with police cap and postbag Teach traffic safety rules Sing helper rhyme 	Flashcards, postbox prop, toy uniform items, storybook, mini envelopes	Writing Practice – Guided to Independent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teacher models writing of each letter on board Children trace letters in workbook (guided) Move to independent writing in workbook Circle the correct letter in a printed worksheet Pair activity: check each other's writing Revise poem line linked to one letter 	Blackboard, chalk, Hindi workbook, worksheets
