Week 19 Monday	Introduction to Letter Mm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce Letter Mm with flashcards □ Say: "M says /m/ - म" (as in monkey, mug, moon) Show mirror to observe lip movement while saying /m/ Practice air and finger tracing Begin with a mystery bag of M-objects Match pictures of Mm words 	Flashcards, mirror, M-object bag, tracing cards	The Hokey Pokey + Left and Right	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce the rhyme "Hokey Pokey" with movements (left/right hand, foot). Practice "Put your right hand in..." using full-body action. Show flashcards of left/right hands and shoes. Children identify their dominant hand. Object game: pick up item on left/right. Left-right walk around the classroom. 	Music player, left/right flashcards, shoes/glove cutouts, toys/books	Introduction to Zoo & Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate the story "Ben Visits the Zoo" using animal flashcards or puppets. Show a picture chart of common zoo animals and name them together. Ask children if they've ever visited a zoo and what animals they saw. Teach an animal rhyme with actions (e.g., "Walking in the Zoo"). Use role-play where each child mimics an animal. Display and discuss rules to follow in a zoo (like not teasing animals). Act out parts with sound effects Picture Talk: Show jungle and food visuals Teach values: effort and teamwork Children sequence story cards 	Soft toy monkey, fake mango, picture cards	Hokey Pokey Dance Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Repeat "Hokey Pokey" focusing on different parts (arms, legs). Play mirror game in pairs: follow left/right hand gestures. Worksheet activity: color the object on the right. Sing and dance with new left/right commands. Mark left/right shoes and match them. Circle the hand used for waving. 	Worksheet, crayons, shoe/glove cutouts, mirror partner setup	Animal Sounds & Movements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Play recorded animal sounds—children guess the animal. Imitate animal sounds and movements (e.g., elephant's trumpet, lion's roar). Read a book with animal sounds and textures. Show a short video of zoo animals moving and making sounds. Ask children to draw their favorite animal and mimic it. Conduct a game: "Which Animal Am I?" based on sound and movement clues. Week 19 Wednesday	Visual-Tactile Letter Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trace M in flour/sand trays Build letter M with clay or sticks Match uppercase and lowercase M on worksheets Practice saying words: moon, mat, mug Add Hindi match words: मछली, मटर Sort Mm vs Non-Mm words 	Clay, tracing trays, cards with mixed letters	Flashcard Sorting Game	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show flashcards of objects pointing left/right. Children place them under "Left" or "Right" column. Play Simon Says with "left" and "right" commands. Do hand tracing—label left and right. Play object placement quiz. Use arrows on wall to follow direction. 	Sorting mat, labeled flashcards, tracing sheets, arrows, glue	Animal Habitats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce the concept of animal homes—caves, nests, dens, etc. Match animals to their homes using cards (e.g., lion-cave, monkey-tree). Make a zoo diorama with toy animals and habitats using chart paper. Show pictures of forest, desert, and water habitats. Play a sorting game: "Where Do I Live?" Sing "Old MacDonald" with habitat references added. 	Cutouts, habitat cards, toy animals, chart paper, glue	Word Association & Picture Matching (य, य)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Display flashcards of य and य words mixed Children match letter to the correct picture Create a "Word Bank Wall" for य and य Add new words daily with children's help Recap letter sounds with a phonics chant Rhyme or short poem recitation using new words 	Picture cards, word wall chart, sticky notes
