Week 2 Monday	Introduction to Sleeping Lines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Theme-Based Learning: Observe and identify sleeping lines in objects (e.g., books, shelves, boards) Observation & Inquiry: "What lines do we see in doors and tables?" Visual Aids: Show a chart with different types of lines Kinesthetic Learning: Walk on taped sleeping lines Worksheet: Trace sleeping lines Rhyme: Recite "Poem: Shapes" with claps 	Tape, visual chart, worksheet printouts, objects with sleeping lines, rhyme card/chart boards	Circle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce the shape "Circle" using a ball, bangle, and coin Let children touch and roll circular objects Sing "A Circle is Like a Ball..." rhyme Finger trace circle in flour tray Use cutouts to make a smiley face Children walk along a big circle drawn on the floor 	Ball, coin, bangle, flour tray, smiley circle cutouts, chalk	Circle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce the circle using flashcards (e.g., coin, wall clock) Let children touch & trace a cardboard circle Conduct a circle-hunt activity in class/home Sing a circle rhyme (e.g., "Round and round the garden") Do guided colouring of a circle on worksheet Discuss: "What else do you see that is round?" 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Circle flashcards Circular cut-outs Rhyme audio Worksheet Crayons 	Introduction of Letter "आ" through Storytelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin with a fun story about "आलू" (e.g., आलू मकूल जाता है) Emphasize the sound "आ" throughout the story Show a flashcard of "आ" and say together: "आ से आलू" Ask: "और क्या-क्या 'आ' से शुरू होता है?" Do simple movements to mimic the shape of "आ" Encourage children to repeat "आ" aloud like a chant 	Flashcards (आलू, आम, आदमी), story visuals, character puppet
Week 2 Tuesday	Zig-Zag & Slanting Lines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visual-Motor Coordination: Draw zig-zag and slanting lines using crayons and rulers Creative Craft: Make zig-zag snakes with paper strips Sensory Exploration: Use sand tray to draw zig-zag/slanting lines with fingers Game-Based Learning: "Line Maze" with toy cars on zig-zag paths Word Sorting: Match line types with images Workbook Tracing Task 	Colored paper, crayons, sand tray, line maze mat, toy cars, sorting cards, workbook	Square	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce "Square" using cushion, tile, napkin Compare Circle vs Square using flashcards Recite "Square has 4 sides..." rhyme Sand tray tracing of square Children use cutouts to make a gift box Walk along square outline on the floor 	Cushion, napkin, tiles, square cutouts, sand tray, chalk	Square	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show real-life squares (handkerchief, window photo) Let children trace a foam square with their finger Do a shape sorting game with cut-outs Draw & colour a square in workbook Display 3 objects and ask: "Which one is square?" Use shape puzzle tray for matching squares 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Square flashcards Square cut-outs Puzzle tray Worksheet Crayons 	Sand & Air Tracing of "आ"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sand tray activity: Trace "आ" using fingers Demonstrate air tracing with big hand movements Ask children to trace "आ" in the air while saying the sound Play "Sky writing": Draw "आ" in the air above their heads Children trace on their partner's back for fun recognition Recap previous day's story and ask where "आ" appeared 	Sand trays, air space, chalkboard demo, hand mirror (optional)
Week 2 Wednesday	Shapes All Around Us	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Picture-Based Discussion: Identify shapes in classroom and nature (sun, clock, window, leaf) Sorting and Matching: Match shape cutouts with real objects Interactive Chart: Stick correct shapes under headings (circle, square, triangle) Kinesthetic Learning: Hop on taped shapes on floor Rhyme Recap with gestures Worksheet: Match shape + line combo 	Shape cutouts, chart, tape, photos of real-life shapes, worksheet, rhyme sheet	Shape Story – "Ria's Shape Day"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate story using puppet/felt board: Ria finds shapes Show circle window & square gift in story Identify and hold shapes from a tray Retell story with children acting as Ria Draw house using circle & square Children match shapes to story objects 	Felt board/puppets, picture cards, shape cutouts, drawing sheet	Triangle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate story: "Tina the Triangle goes to the mountain" Show triangle items (pizza slice, signboard) Let children walk in a triangle drawn on the floor Match triangle cut-outs to object photos Triangle drawing on worksheet Talk about where we see triangles in real life 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Triangle flashcards Triangle cut-outs Tape/floor chalk Worksheet 	Picture Talk + Rhythmic Poem (आकार)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show picture flashcards (आम, आदमी, आलू) one by one Talk about each picture – where do we see it? Who uses it? Emphasize starting sound "आ" in each word Recite the rhyme "आकार" with rhythm and hand movements Ask children to repeat and do the actions Ask: "आपको कौन-सा आकार पसंद है?" 	Flashcards, poem chart/poster, rhyme audio (if available)
