Week 20 Monday	Introduction to Letter Nn Phonic Sound: /n/ Hindi: न	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show and say phonic chant: "N says /n/ – like net, nest, nose" Air tracing: Trace uppercase and lowercase Nn in the air Sand tray tracing for Nn Match objects to letter N flashcards (net, nail, nest) Sound bag game: Pull out objects beginning with /n/ Play "Nn says..." game for recognition 	Flashcards (net, nose, nest), sand tray, letter cards, real objects (nail, nut, napkin)	Ben and Bob's Adventure + Thick and Thin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate story of Ben and Bob exploring thick trees and thin vines. Use hand gestures to show "thick" and "thin." Show real objects (book vs. notebook). Children sort items as thick or thin. Trace thick and thin lines. Recap story vocabulary using actions. 	Story props, thick & thin items, picture cards, tracing sheets, crayons	Introduction to Zoo Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin with the story "Ben and Bella's Trip to the Zoo" using expressions and visuals. Show flashcards of common zoo animals (lion, giraffe, elephant, zebra). Ask children to name and mimic each animal's sound. Use an interactive video showing zoo animal enclosures. Begin a class discussion: "Which animal do you like most?" Introduce animal movement imitation (walk like an elephant, roar like a lion). Week 20 Tuesday	Poem: I Had a Little Turtle Rhyme with Actions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recite the rhyme with hand motions (swimming, hiding) Puppet play: Use a turtle puppet to act out the story Emphasize rhyming words "turtle-hurtle" Group movement: Walk like turtles during rhyme Picture talk: "Where do turtles live?" Moral discussion: "We must be calm like the turtle" 	Turtle puppet, rhyme poster, visuals of turtles and ponds, audio recording	Near and Far (Concept Building)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Place a toy near and far; ask "Where is it?" Play "Walk to the toy" for near/far understanding. Show flashcards of objects placed at distances. Use arm gestures: stretch for "far", close hands for "near." Sing "Near or Far" rhyme. Worksheet: identify near/far. 	Toy objects, floor markers, flashcards, worksheet, music	Animal Sounds & Movements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Play recorded animal sounds (lion, monkey, elephant, tiger). Let children guess and match the sound to the animal. Introduce "Guess Who?" with sound clues. Imitate animal movements together (hop like kangaroo, swing like monkey). Conduct "Simon Says" with zoo animal movements. Recap with a rhyme: "In the Zoo..." describing each animal. Week 20 Wednesday	Turtle Craft Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show a turtle model and discuss its body parts Make turtle shell using paper bowls or green paper Decorate shell with patterns Write/Trace "N is for Nest" on worksheet Display all turtles on board Talk about how turtles move and protect themselves 	Paper bowls/ green paper, glue, crayons, scissors (child-safe), sample craft	Sorting and Observation Games	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sorting tray: children sort thick vs. thin items. Use chalk, crayons, ropes to compare. Conduct quick quiz: "Is this thick or thin?" Hide toys and identify near/far ones. Label classroom objects as near/far. Practice line walking activity. 	Sorting tray, chalks, ropes, hidden toys, labels, stickers	Zoo Role Play Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set up a pretend zoo in the classroom with labeled enclosures. Assign roles: animals and zookeepers. Children act as animals showing how they move/ eat. Zookeepers feed toy animals and clean enclosures. Teach the phrase: "Zookeepers care for animals." Reflect: "How do we care for animals at home or outside?" 	Toy animals, labels, enclosures (boxes/ ropes), zookeeper props (hats, brushes)	Story-based Introduction of स	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce letter स through story prompt Show flashcards: सूरज, साँप, साबुन Air writing and sky tracing of स Sand tray tracing of स Identify स words in classroom objects Connect स से सूर्यजन to poem scene 	Flashcards, sand tray, toy train, object props
