Week 21 Monday	Introduction to Letter Oo Phonic Sound: /o/ Hindi: ओ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce letter Oo with flashcards and phonics chant: "O says /o/ – like orange, owl"</li> <li>Show and identify real objects starting with /o/</li> <li>Air trace uppercase and lowercase Oo</li> <li>Practice Oo writing in sand/flour tray</li> <li>Song time: Letter Oo phonics song</li> <li>Match objects to Oo flashcards</li> </ul>	Flashcards (orange, owl, ox), phonics song audio, sand tray, letter cards	I Know My Numbers 31–40	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce floor number line from 1–40, focus on 31–40.</li> <li>Children walk on numbers and identify aloud.</li> <li>Use flashcards 31–40 to reinforce recognition.</li> <li>Trace numbers using finger on large cards.</li> <li>Count claps from 31–40.</li> <li>Practice air-tracing numbers.</li> </ul>	Floor number line, number flashcards, large number cards	Introduction to Animal Homes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Begin with a story "Where Do Animals Live?" featuring lion, rabbit, bird, and bee.</li> <li>Use flashcards showing animals and homes.</li> <li>Let children guess each animal's home.</li> <li>Sing a rhyme on animal homes.</li> <li>Show real pictures or a video of animal homes.</li> <li>Ask: "Where do you go after school?" to build connection.</li> </ul>	Storybook or teacher-made story visuals, animal-home flashcards, speaker for rhyme, zoo video clip	Story-Based Introduction of ह, कष	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Begin with a warm-up rhyme to engage children</li> <li>Introduce letters ह and कष on the board</li> <li>Narrate the story बच्चों की टैलगाड़ी with expressions and voice modulation</li> <li>Emphasize ह/कष words while telling the story</li> <li>Ask comprehension questions about the story</li> <li>Show flashcards of words starting with ह and कष</li> </ul>	Story cards, board, chalk, flashcards
Week 21 Tuesday	Story: Mummy's Kitchen Garden	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Narrate story using toy vegetables/fruits or visual aids</li> <li>Emphasize items like okra (bhindi) and onion</li> <li>Class discussion: "What grows in your kitchen garden?"</li> <li>Recap sound /o/ with story objects</li> <li>Identify O-words from story</li> <li>Moral: "Healthy food helps us grow strong"</li> </ul>	Toy fruits/vegetables, story cards, chart paper with vegetables, visuals of garden	Count and Write Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Count aloud objects in sets of 31 to 40.</li> <li>Give beads/buttons to count and place in groups.</li> <li>Use rows of ten to group 31–40.</li> <li>Trace dotted number sheets (31–40).</li> <li>Draw 33 balloons and write the number.</li> <li>Use tracing boards for pencil practice.</li> </ul>	Objects for counting, tracing sheets, pencils, crayons	Matching Animals to Homes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Begin with flashcards of pictures.</li> <li>Display cards of homes (nest, cave, kennel).</li> <li>Children match animal to home.</li> <li>Do a "Find My Home" movement game.</li> <li>Use puzzles for reinforcement.</li> <li>Recap with a shorthyme.</li> </ul>	Picture flashcards, printed animal-home matching cards, puzzles, rhyme audio	Letter Tracing & Sound Practice – ह	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Demonstrate air tracing of ह with big hand movements</li> <li>Practice finger tracing in sand trays</li> <li>Children write ह in four-line notebooks</li> <li>Chant and repeat "ह से हल, हाथ, हंसना" together</li> <li>Show picture cards and match to the letter ह</li> <li>Use simple sentences with ह words</li> </ul>	Sand trays, four-line notebooks, chalk, picture cards
Week 21 Wednesday	Role-Play: Kitchen Garden Setup	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Set up a pretend kitchen garden corner in class</li> <li>Children role-play Mummy, gardener, helper</li> <li>Each child picks a vegetable and names it</li> <li>Identify which vegetables begin with "O"</li> <li>Recap story while role-playing</li> <li>Draw "My Kitchen Garden"</li> </ul>	Aprons, fake fruits/vegetables, baskets, hats, flashcards, drawing sheet & crayons	Group Activity – Bead String & Story	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Narrate a number story about collecting pebbles (31–40).</li> <li>Children string 31–40 beads while counting.</li> <li>Identify number of items each day in the story.</li> <li>Match beads with number cards.</li> <li>Draw 36 apples and count aloud.</li> <li>Color beads with 3 colors.</li> </ul>	Story props, beads, strings, number cards, drawing sheets	Animal Role Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Begin with a fun movement warm-up.</li> <li>Assign animals (e.g., lion, bird, rabbit) to kids.</li> <li>Children act and pretend to go to their home.</li> <li>Set up "homes" in class corners.</li> <li>Observe and describe the animals' actions.</li> <li>End with a clap-and-name game.</li> </ul>	Animal props, labels for classroom corners (cave, nest, etc.), music for movement	Letter Tracing & Sound Practice – कष	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce the shape and strokes of कष on the board</li> <li>Practice air and sand tracing of कष</li> <li>Children write कष in notebooks</li> <li>Chant "कष से कषमा, कषत्रयि, कषत" together</li> <li>Match picture cards to कष words</li> <li>Use sentences with कष words in class discussion</li> </ul>	Sand trays, notebooks, chalk, picture cards

Week 21 Thursday	Worksheet: I Can Match + Oo Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce the "I Can Match" worksheet (match Oo objects)</li> <li>Practice tracing Oo on worksheet (Kk-Oo range)</li> <li>Letter Oo object sorting – find pictures that start with /o/</li> <li>Revise phonic chant and sound /o/</li> <li>Letter hunt in classroom (find hidden O cards)</li> <li>Group reading: Oo storybook (if available)</li> </ul>	Worksheet printout, letter Oo tracing cards, cut-out images, books starting with O	Number Puzzle and Game Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide mixed number cards (31–40) for arranging in sequence.</li> <li>Use puzzle cutouts to complete number strip.</li> <li>Play musical numbers: stop at number 35!</li> <li>Practice writing missing numbers (e.g., 33, __, 35).</li> <li>Draw and color 39 stars.</li> <li>Peer check answers.</li> </ul>	Number puzzles, cards, worksheet strips, crayons	Animal Habitat Craft	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recall all animals and homes learned.</li> <li>Children choose one animal to work on.</li> <li>Use paper/craft items to create their home.</li> <li>Paste animal beside its home.</li> <li>Display all crafts on a "Jungle Wall."</li> <li>Appreciate and explain everyone's work.</li> </ul>	A4 paper, colored paper, glue, scissors, animal pictures, twigs/cotton for craft	Group Activities – Rail Game & Letter Hunt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Explain the rail bogie game with ह/कष words on bogies</li> <li>Children build the train in the right order</li> <li>Play letter hunt: hide ह and कष cutouts in class</li> <li>Children find a cutout and say a related word</li> <li>Discuss which letter has more words they know</li> <li>Quick recap of new words learnt</li> </ul>	Train bogie cutouts, letter cutouts, basket, flashcards
Week 21 Friday	Art & Food Sorting Day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Vegetable printing using okra and onion</li> <li>Children press vegetable in paint and stamp on paper</li> <li>Food sorting: Healthy vs Junk</li> <li>Discussion: "Which foods are from the garden?"</li> <li>"O Basket" game – children identify or bring objects starting with O</li> <li>Recap rhyme and story</li> </ul>	Okra, onion, paint, paper, food picture cards, real/pretend food models, baskets	Color-by-Number & Recap	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Revise 31–40 through song or rhyme.</li> <li>Use color code sheet (e.g., 31=red, 32=blue).</li> <li>Children color shapes with matching numbers.</li> <li>Count library books together (real-life example).</li> <li>Recap story "Lisa and the Pebbles."</li> <li>Complete worksheet activity.</li> </ul>	Color-by-number sheet, coloring pencils, real-life objects (books)	Sorting and Outdoor Connection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Begin with a sorting game: land, water, or tree homes.</li> <li>Show a short nature video or go on a nature walk.</li> <li>Let children spot animal homes if possible.</li> <li>Recap through Q&amp;A ("Where does the rabbit live?").</li> <li>Sing closing rhyme.</li> <li>Discuss: "Why do animals need homes?"</li> </ul>	Sorting tray with animal pictures, outdoor walk prep or nature video, closing rhyme audio, visual aid cards	Craft & Role-Play + Recap	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make a handprint craft and write "हैं से हाथ"</li> <li>Draw a king with shield for "कषत्रयि"</li> <li>Role-play बच्चों की रेलगाड़ी with children as passengers/train</li> <li>Revise ह and कष words through a quick quiz</li> <li>Peer sharing – each child says 1 ह/कष word</li> <li>Reflect on moral: forgiveness and learning from mistakes</li> </ul>	Paint, A4 sheets, crayons, crown props, shield drawing
