Week 24 Monday	Letter Introduction – Qq	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce letter Qq with sound /kw/</li> <li>Show real items: queen crown, quilt, quill</li> <li>Phonics chant: “Q says /kw/, like queen and quack”</li> <li>Use mirror to pronounce /kw/ clearly</li> <li>Compare with Hindi sound: क्व (क + व blend)</li> <li>Match object cards with letter Q</li> </ul>	Toy crown, quilt image, flashcards (Queen, Quack), phonics song cards	Five Little Ducks Rhyme + Backward Counting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce the rhyme “Five Little Ducks Went Out One Day”.</li> <li>Use finger puppets or visuals for ducks.</li> <li>Emphasize backward counting (5–0).</li> <li>Ask children to repeat the numbers after each verse.</li> <li>Sing and act with movements.</li> <li>Clap while counting backward.</li> </ul>	Finger/stick puppets, duck cutouts, rhyme audio/video	Introduction to Farm Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Storytelling with “Three Ben’s Farm Trip” using pictures</li> <li>Introduce key farm animals (cow, sheep, hen, pig)</li> <li>Animal sound game: moo, baa, oink</li> <li>Use flashcards to name animals</li> <li>Children repeat animal names and their uses (milk, wool, eggs)</li> <li>Rhyme time: “Old MacDonald Had a Farm”</li> </ul>	Picture book or printed story visuals, farm animal flashcards	Introduction of क्ष, त्र, ज्ञ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce the concept of संयुक्ताक्षर and explain that these are special combined consonants</li> <li>Show big flashcards for क्ष, त्र, ज्ञ and pronounce them slowly</li> <li>Give examples: क्षमा, मंदिर, ज्ञान and link them to real-life actions</li> <li>Air trace each conjunct letter with children</li> <li>Blackboard writing practice for correct formation</li> <li>Short discussion on where these letters are seen in daily life</li> </ul>	Flashcards, chalkboard, chart of conjunct letters
Week 24 Tuesday	Alphabet Tracing Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Finger trace Qq in sand tray or salt</li> <li>Write Qq using chalk on slate or whiteboard</li> <li>Focus on curve + slash stroke for capital Q</li> <li>Complete Pp–Tt worksheet, highlighting Qq</li> <li>Match Q-words with pictures on worksheet</li> <li>Play “What starts with Q?”</li> </ul>	Sand trays, Pp–Tt worksheet, chalk slates, flashcards	Backward Number Line (10–0)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create a large floor number line (10–0).</li> <li>Children hop backward from 10 to 0.</li> <li>Use flashcards to call numbers aloud.</li> <li>Play “Stand on the number before 6”.</li> <li>Encourage reverse counting in pairs.</li> <li>Reinforce using counting songs.</li> </ul>	Floor number cards, hopscotch mat, number flashcards	What Do Farm Animals Give Us?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recap rhyme and sounds</li> <li>Flashcard quiz – “Who gives milk?”</li> <li>Sorting activity: animals and their products (e.g., cow milk)</li> <li>Group discussion: What do we eat that comes from farms?</li> <li>Use toy food and toy animals for demonstration</li> <li>Farm video showing animals and their homes</li> </ul>	Toy animals and food items, flashcards, farm video	Word Examples & Story Link	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recap yesterday’s letters and sounds</li> <li>Show picture flashcards: शक्तिषा, त्रकिण, वज्जिापन</li> <li>Read ज्ञान का दीपक, highlighting words with क्ष/त्र/ज्ञ</li> <li>Pause during story to repeat key words aloud together</li> <li>Ask children to share any new words they know with these letters</li> <li>End with moral: Knowledge + Friendship = Light</li> </ul>	Storybook “ज्ञान का दीपक”, picture flashcards, word cards
Week 24 Wednesday	Poem Recitation – Mary Mary Quite Contrary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recite the rhyme with melody and hand gestures</li> <li>Use a queen puppet or finger doll while reciting</li> <li>Identify rhyming words: contrary–Mary, grow–row</li> <li>Discuss garden items from the poem</li> <li>Link poem vocabulary to visuals (bell, shell, flower)</li> <li>Emphasize rhythm with claps or a tambourine</li> </ul>	Queen puppet/ finger doll, rhyme flashcards, flowers visuals	Flashcard Flip + Missing Number Puzzle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show number flashcards 10–0 in random order.</li> <li>Flip and hide one number, ask children to guess.</li> <li>Play fill-in-the-gap on board: 10, __, 8...</li> <li>Children write missing numbers.</li> <li>Play “What comes before?” with flashcards.</li> <li>Repeat as group game.</li> </ul>	Flashcards (0–10), whiteboard, chalk, puzzle strips	Baby Animals on the Farm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Match adult animals to their babies (e.g., cow–calf)</li> <li>Story about “Mama Hen and Her Chicks”</li> <li>“Guess the Baby” game using clues</li> <li>Farm animal baby puzzle</li> <li>Group activity: children act like animal babies</li> <li>Color a baby animal worksheet</li> </ul>	Animal–baby flashcards, worksheets, coloring material	Writing & Sand Tray Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Practice tracing letters in the air</li> <li>Use sand trays for tactile tracing of each conjunct</li> <li>Give dotted worksheets for guided writing</li> <li>Play “Find the Letter” – circle correct conjuncts from a mixed set</li> <li>Let children form letters using clay for motor skills</li> <li>Review vocabulary words again with meaning</li> </ul>	Sand trays, worksheets, clay, pencils
