Week 25 Monday	Letter Rr – Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce letter Rr and sound /r/ with a “car engine” sound Show R objects: rose, rabbit, rainbow, ring Use mirror for mouth shape practice Phonics chant: “R says /r/, like rabbit” Compare with Hindi letter: र Match pictures with the Rr sound 	Flashcards, real/toy objects (rose, rabbit), mirror, phonics sound chart	Story-Based Learning: Ben & Max	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate “Ben and Little Max” story. Emphasize where Max goes: under the table, on the chair. Ask positional questions during narration. Repeat key phrases: “Max is under...”, “Max is on...”. Children act out the story. Use puppets or toys for support. 	Picture book, puppets, chair, table, toy figure	Introduction to the Market	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Picture Talk: Show images of local markets (fruit stalls, vendors). Identify shops (vegetable, grocery, clothes, toy). Discuss what people do in a market. Talk about busy sounds, colours, smells. Introduce vocabulary (vendor, scale, basket). Use flashcards to match shop type with items. 	Market photos, flashcards, chart	Varnamala Recap Song & Oral Drill	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin with वरुणमाला गीत (External Audio/Video) for pronunciation Recap letters अ to ज्ञ orally in chorus Show each letter with a picture card and say aloud (अ – अनाद, आ – आम, etc.) Quick oral quiz: “Which letter comes after ट?” Use rhyming sentences for memory (e.g., “क – कबूतर उड़ता है”) Moral talk: Why revision makes us better 	Audio/video of वरुणमाला गीत, letter flashcards, picture cards
Week 25 Tuesday	Tracing + Sound Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Finger trace Rr on sandpaper or rice tray Air trace big and small R with arm movements Complete Pp–Tt worksheet with focus on Rr Match Rr objects with letter cards Practice “R is for Rose” aloud Build Rr using blocks 	Sand tray, worksheet Pp–Tt, building blocks, letter cards	Object Placement Game	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hand toys to children. Give instructions: “Put the toy on the table.” Repeat with different items and places. Children follow and say the position. Ask peers to verify correctness. Reinforce vocabulary with flashcards. 	Toy animals, table, chair, flashcards	Storytime – “Bella Goes to the Market”	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate story of Bella’s first visit to the market. Highlight polite words (please, thank you). Ask questions: “What did Bella buy?” Discuss interactions between seller and customer. Act out a small scene from the story. Introduce new words from the story. 	Story cards, soft puppets	Writing Practice (अ–ज्ञ)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Give lined worksheets /slates for writing A–ज्ञ Demonstrate correct strokes on board Peer-check: exchange sheets and spot neat handwriting Use “Letter of the Day” – write and draw one word Chant letters while writing to build rhythm Give smiley/star stickers for neat work 	Worksheets, pencils, slates, chalk, reward stickers
Week 25 Wednesday	Poem Time – Flowers Everywhere	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recite the poem with hand gestures and petal-opening actions Use real or paper flowers to dramatize rhyme Identify rhyming words: air–everywhere Display flower visuals: rose, lily, daisy Let children repeat lines in groups Talk about where flowers grow 	Real/paper flowers, flower flashcards, poem chart, flower picture book	Visual Cards + Role Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show flashcards with scenes (e.g., cat under bed, book on shelf). Children identify the position verbally. Invite children to act out “on” and “under”. Use role-play props (mat, stool, bed setup). Peer observation for reinforcement. Add body movement songs. 	Flashcards, mat, stool, role-play props	Market Role Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set up a pretend market in class. Assign roles: seller, buyer, helper. Use fake fruits, veggies, grocery items. Use pretend money to “buy” items. Children interact, ask prices, make choices. Emphasize politeness and turn-taking. 	Pretend stalls, toy fruits/veggies, fake money	Letter-Sound Association & Matching Game	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show each letter with a related object (ख – खरगोश, ट – टमाटर) Play letter–picture matching game Children speak sentences with given letter (e.g., “ज – जल से पानी आता है”) Introduce a “mystery picture” and guess its starting letter Role-play: shopkeeper and customer using letter flashcards Revise the वरुणमाला गीत together 	Matching cards, real objects, role-play props, letter flashcards
