Week 28 Monday	Introduction to Letter Uu	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce uppercase and lowercase Uu using flashcards and phonics chant: "U says /ʌ/ like umbrella, under" Hindi equivalent: उ Air trace Uu with fingers while saying the sound Use sand trays and crayons for tactile tracing Show real objects: umbrella, utensils, up arrow Sing Uu phonics song 	Flashcards, sand tray, crayons, umbrella, utensils	Count & Match (41–45)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show 41–45 flashcards with picture groups. Children count and match items (e.g., stars, apples) to number cards. Use group counting aloud. Practice sand tray writing. Match object bundles to numbers. Play "Find the Match" challenge. 	Number flashcards, picture cards, sand tray, objects	Introduction to Vegetables through Song	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin with rhyme: "Vegetables are good for me..." with hand actions Show real/plastic vegetables for name recognition Children hold and identify vegetables Picture talk using flashcards Introduce keywords: tomato, carrot, spinach Circle time: "Who ate a veggie today?" 	Real/plastic vegetables, vegetable flashcards, rhyme audio, pictures	Introduction to Letter Riddles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin with simple riddles like "Main ek akshar hoon, mere bina 'kabootar' adhoora hai." (Answer: क) Encourage guessing and clapping for correct answers Show the letter card after each answer Ask children to repeat the word and trace the letter in the air Discuss objects starting with that letter Recite poem lines related to the letter 	Riddle flashcards, letter cards, picture props
Week 28 Tuesday	Poem Recitation: Puff-a-Train	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recite rhyme with rhythm and movement (Choo choo, puff puff) Break the poem into parts and repeat with claps Use toy trains or train drawings on the board Children form a "train" line and act out the poem Teach train vocabulary: puff, track, tunnel Emphasize the Uu sound in train movement ("up the hill, under the bridge") 	Poem flashcards, toy trains, chalkboard train sketch	Count & Match (46–50)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continue match activity for 46–50. Build Lego towers of matching numbers. Match number cards to objects in baskets. Count using finger tapping. Practice writing on mini boards. Colour count: draw 46–50 objects. 	Lego, mini boards, number baskets, crayons	Vegetable Rhyme & Taste Fun	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Repeat vegetable rhyme with more actions Optional: Let children taste small bits of vegetables (if permitted) Describe taste and color Flashcard revision game: name that veggie! Colouring worksheet of vegetables Talk about soft vs crunchy vegetables 	Boiled/taste-safe veggies, worksheet printouts, flashcards, crayons	Picture Clues & Poem Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show pictures (कमल, केला, कतिब) and ask "Which letter does it start with?" Children guess and hold up correct flashcard Recite बोलो बोलो क्या है ये? together Emphasize target letters in rhyme words Act out objects from the poem Encourage turn taking in answering 	Picture cards, flashcards, rhyme poster
Week 28 Wednesday	Story-Based Train Role Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create a pretend railway station corner Children role-play: puff through tunnels, pick passengers Use props like caps, tickets, whistles Use directional Uu words: up, under, until Link the movement to letter sound recognition Discuss real-life train experience: "Have you seen a puffing train?" 	Train props, paper tickets, whistle, cones for tunnel	Before, After, Between (41–45)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lay number line (41–50) on floor. Ask: "What comes after 43?" or "Before 44?" Hop to correct number on floor. Use flashcard guessing game. Play peer number quiz. Draw and write before/after numbers. 	Floor line cards, chalk, flashcards, drawing sheet	Vegetable Market Role-Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set up pretend market in class Assign roles: vegetable seller, buyer, helper Use tokens/coins for pretend payment Revise veggie names while "buying" Math fun: count the veggies bought Rhyme revision at end with actions 	Toy vegetables, plastic baskets, paper tokens/coins, name tags	Flashcard Play & Sound Matching	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read a riddle, children pick correct letter card Play "Match the Sound" – say a word match to starting letter Trace letter in sand or on paper after guessing Group riddles: small groups solve & act out answers Clap and cheer for correct answers Revise letters learned so far 	Flashcards, sand trays, worksheets
