Week 29 Monday	Introduction to Letter Vv	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce uppercase and lowercase Vv using flashcards and phonics chant: "V says /v/ like van, vegetables, violin"</li> <li>Hindi Equivalent: व</li> <li>Air trace Vv with fingers and trace in sand tray</li> <li>Show real or toy objects: van, vase, vest, violin</li> <li>Play phonics song with /v/ sound emphasis</li> <li>Begin letter Vv workbook tracing</li> </ul>	Flashcards, sand tray, phonics song, toy van/vest, crayons	Missing Number Puzzle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use number cards 1–20 with gaps (e.g., 11, __, 13).</li> <li>Let children find and fill missing cards.</li> <li>Match missing cards to number train compartments.</li> <li>Play circle game—child fills number when called.</li> <li>Recite 1–20 together aloud.</li> <li>Do "jump to the missing number" floor game.</li> </ul>	Number cards, number train cut-outs, floor tape	Introduction to Flowers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show real or artificial flowers (rose, sunflower, lotus, marigold).</li> <li>Introduce each flower by name, color, and smell.</li> <li>Use flashcards to revise the names.</li> <li>Let children smell and touch flower petals.</li> <li>Sing a rhyme: 'Pretty Flowers All Around'.</li> <li>Children draw their favorite flower.</li> </ul>	Real/artificial flowers, flashcards, drawing sheets, crayons	Phonic Sounds & Story Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Revise swar and vyanjan sounds aloud</li> <li>Show how two letters combine to form words (e.g., क + म = कम)</li> <li>Introduce 3–4 simple words from the story शब्दों का संसार</li> <li>Use flashcards for sound-to-word demonstration</li> <li>Children repeat each new word aloud</li> <li>Moral discussion on how words build language</li> </ul>	Swar/vyanjan chart, story cards, letter flashcards
Week 29 Tuesday	Recap: Puff-a-Train Poem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recite Puff-a-Train with clapping/stomping actions</li> <li>Use a toy train or mats as train compartments</li> <li>Discuss rhyme sequence: where the train goes, what sounds it makes</li> <li>Ask: "Who remembers what the train said?"</li> <li>Practice saying /v/ sound every time the train puffs</li> <li>Reinforce vocabulary from rhyme using visuals</li> </ul>	Poem chart, toy trains, mats/chairs for pretend train	Number Train & Ladder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue train activity with new missing numbers.</li> <li>Distribute ladder chart—children fill gaps.</li> <li>Count aloud as a group while pointing to numbers.</li> <li>Partner puzzle: pairs complete train gaps.</li> <li>Do peer-checking of number order.</li> <li>Reinforce through clap-and-count 1–20.</li> </ul>	Paper trains, ladder charts, markers, puzzles	Flower Identification and Sensory Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Play a flower picture matching game.</li> <li>Show colorful flashcards of common flowers.</li> <li>Conduct a picture talk on a flower garden poster.</li> <li>Let children describe what they see.</li> <li>Sort flower cut-outs by size or color.</li> <li>Revise flower names with flashcards again.</li> </ul>	Flower flashcards, flower cut-outs, poster of garden	Sand Tray Writing Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Demonstrate writing 2–3 letter words in sand tray</li> <li>Children trace words like घर, कलम, फल</li> <li>Pronounce each letter while tracing</li> <li>Match word with its picture card</li> <li>Peer-to-peer letter correction activity</li> <li>Display traced words for class review</li> </ul>	Sand trays, picture cards, letter cards
Week 29 Wednesday	Story Retelling: The Exciting Train Adventure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Narrate the story again with toys and movement</li> <li>Ask questions: "Who was on the train?" "Where did they go?"</li> <li>Let children act out scenes: engine driver, passenger</li> <li>Draw the train journey on the board using markers</li> <li>Identify words from the story that start with V (e.g., van waiting at station)</li> <li>Make a story train line with picture cards</li> </ul>	Story props, markers, pictures from the story	Ordering Numbers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Jumbled cards 1–20—children arrange in sequence.</li> <li>Group game: order character names by numbers.</li> <li>"Tell the next number" activity.</li> <li>Worksheet practice of ordering sequences.</li> <li>Number board quiz: pick &amp; order random numbers.</li> <li>Sing counting song 1–20 with body actions.</li> </ul>	Number cards, worksheet, board cards, music	Story and Rhyme: Flowers Bloom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Narrate a story: a child waters plants and flowers bloom.</li> <li>Discuss how flowers grow with care.</li> <li>Emphasize not picking flowers to protect nature.</li> <li>Sing the flower rhyme with actions.</li> <li>Let children mimic flower blooming.</li> <li>Color a worksheet of blooming flowers.</li> </ul>	Storybook, rhyme lyrics, worksheet, crayons	Picture to Word Game & Word Building	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show pictures (pen, apple, sun) and ask for Hindi word</li> <li>Break the word into letters (घ + र = घर)</li> <li>Provide letter cards to arrange into the word</li> <li>Use clues from images to guess the word</li> <li>Children read their formed word aloud</li> <li>Group applause for each correct word</li> </ul>	Image flashcards, letter cards, board
