Week 6 Monday	Introduction to Letter Dd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phonics Play: Chant "D says /d/ – like ड़" with examples (dog, drum, duck) Air Tracing: Practice capital and small Dd in air with actions Visual Aids: Show letter Dd and flashcards Storytelling: Short tale "Danny the Dog" Matching Game: Letter D to object cards Worksheet: Trace and color uppercase & lowercase Dd 	Flashcards, storybook, alphabet chart, tracing worksheet, chalk/crayons	I Know My Numbers 1–10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce numbers 1–10 using colorful flashcards and a number chart Recite the numbers loudly as a class while pointing Show finger counting for each number Let children walk and count 10 steps together Match each number with real classroom items (1 bag, 2 pencils, etc.) End with a rhyme: "1, 2, Buckle My Shoe" 	Number flashcards, number chart, daily objects	My Name and My Photo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Greet each child using their name and show their photo. Match photo cards with printed name tags. Let children say their name aloud. Teacher sings "What's your name?" song. Kids decorate their name card with stickers. Name calling game: "Who is missing?" with photo. 	Name cards, student photos, glue, stickers	Story-Based Introduction of ओ and औ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate a short story featuring ओम, ओखली, औरत, औज़ार Show large picture cards of ओ and औ objects Emphasize the sounds "ओ" and "औ" during the story Conduct sound repetition with the class Ask: "Which word started with ओ?" "Which with औ?" Encourage children to share other examples from home 	Story cards, flashcards of ओ/औ objects, real objects like ओखली, small tools
Week 6 Tuesday	Story Time & Puppet Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Story Recap: "Danny the Dog" with puppets Puppet Play: Use doll and dog puppets to show D-word story Mystery D-Bag: Pull out and name D-objects (drum, dice, duck) Role Play: Act like different D characters Song & Chant: Dd rhyme with movement Matching Game: Sort D-word images with letter D 	Puppets, bag of D objects, role-play hats, printed cards, musical chant recording	Number Tracing & Recognition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children trace numbers in sand trays using fingers Use play dough to form numbers 1–10 Worksheet: trace and write 1–5 Sing: "Ten Little Fingers" while showing actions Group game: match number to quantity (e.g., 4 balls) Art: draw a group of 3 or 5 items 	Sand tray, play dough, worksheet (1–5), drawing paper	My Face and Body Parts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children look into mirrors to observe their face. Sing "Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes" song. Point and name face parts with a buddy. Use flashcards of eyes, nose, mouth, etc. Trace hand and foot on paper. Show body part puzzles to identify & assemble. 	Mirrors, body part flashcards, puzzles, paper, crayons	Visual Recognition & Sound Association	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Display flashcards of ओ and औ words (ओम, ओम, औरत, औज़ार) Real-life object show –and-tell for sound connection Phonic clap: clap once for each syllable in given words Match picture to the correct letter chart (ओ or औ) Conduct "Find the Letter" game on wall chart Recite short lines of the poem "सपने" 	Flashcards, real objects, wall chart, poem chart
Week 6 Wednesday	Shapes & Colours Connection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kinesthetic Activity: Walk on floor-taped curved lines (spiral, circle) Sensory Play: Finger trace D and curved shapes in sand Sorting Game: Match pom-poms with same colour bowls Visual Aids: Match curved items (drum, donut) to shapes Recap colour names through "Colour Circle Game" Workbook tracing activity 	Tape, sand tray, pom-poms, bowls, shape/colour cards, worksheet	Count and Write (1–10)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Count objects in sets (blocks, erasers, spoons) Show "Count and Write" worksheet (1–10) Children write the number under each object group Play a circle counting game: pass a ball while counting Match pictures to correct number card Recap numbers 1–10 using a counting song 	Worksheet (Count & Write), real objects, number cards	How I Feel Today	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children choose an emotion card that shows how they feel. Teacher discusses "Why do you feel this way?" Read a story showing happy/sad characters. Act out facial expressions (happy, sad, angry). Feeling circle: Children share and listen. Draw how you feel today. 	Emotion flashcards, storybook, crayons, paper	Air & Sand Tracing of ओ and औ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Demonstrate big arm air tracing of ओ and औ Let children trace letters in salt/sand trays Finger tracing on textured/sandpaper letters Pair activity: trace on partner's palm for fun recognition Show correct stroke order on board Revise through oral repetition of words starting with each letter 	Sand trays, textured letters, blackboard, chalk
