Week 9 Monday	Letter Ff Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phonics Sound: Chant "F says /f/ – like फ़" with examples (fan, fish, flower) Air Tracing: Use pointer finger to trace capital and small F in air Finger Tracing: Trace Ff on sand/flour tray while saying sound aloud Flashcard Play: Show Ff object cards (fan, fork, frog) Worksheet: Trace uppercase and lowercase Ff 	Flashcards, sand tray/flour tray, Ff worksheet, real F objects	Story Introduction – Tall and Short	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate "Ben and Bob's Jungle Adventure" focusing on animal heights. Use puppets or cutouts to reinforce "tall" vs. "short". Ask concept-check questions: "Who is taller – Ben or Bob?" Let kids retell using finger puppets. Play simple height comparison game. Sing a "tall-short" rhyme. 	Animal puppets, visual story props, chart paper, markers	Introduction to Hygiene	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Storytelling: "Bella's Clean Day" – how she brushes, bathes, and keeps clean Use flashcards of hygiene habits Sing rhyme "This is the way..." Discuss why we need to stay clean Show handwashing steps Children share morning routine 	Storybook or puppet, hygiene flashcards, handwash demo chart, song audio	Story-Based Introduction of ग, घ, ङ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrate कहानी अच्छे बच्चे with expressions and gestures Introduce letters ग, घ, ङ through story characters/objects (ग – गाय, घ – घट, ङ – अंगूर) Discuss the moral of the story and link each letter with a good habit Show real or picture objects for each letter Ask children to repeat the letter sounds aloud Conduct a short Q&A on story events 	Story cards, flashcards, toy cow, toy house, grape pictures
Week 9 Tuesday	Sound & Object Matching	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Activity – F Sound Basket: Pick and name items from a basket (e.g., fan, frog, flower) Game: Sort "F or Not F?" objects Phonics Song: Sing "F is for fan, fish, flower" with gestures Air Writing: Group tracing of capital F using fingers Practice identifying F words in picture story 	Basket with F objects, F and non-F picture cards, phonics song audio	Real-Life Comparison – Tall and Short	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show objects like pencil vs. crayon, chair vs. stool. Children compare and say: "I am taller than..." Use soft blocks to build short and tall stacks. Partner activity: stand and compare. Match photos of tall/short things. Record findings on board. 	Classroom items, blocks, visual cards, soft toys	Hygiene Tools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Display real items: soap, brush, towel, etc. "Name that tool" guessing game Sorting: hygiene vs. non-hygiene pictures Hygiene basket setup game Discuss why each item is useful Colour a toothbrush and towel picture 	Real hygiene tools, picture cutouts, hygiene item flashcards, colouring worksheet	Air Tracing & Sand Tray Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Demonstrate air tracing of ग, घ, ङ with big hand movements Let children practice tracing in sand trays Say letter sounds as they trace Show correct stroke order on the board Have children form letters with their fingers in the air End with a short sound rhyme ("ग से गाना, घ से घोड़ा") 	Sand trays, flashcards, blackboard, chalk
Week 9 Wednesday	Rhyming & Emotional Connection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rhyme Time: Recite Mummy with expressions and actions Moral Discussion: Talk about how our mothers care for us Drawing Activity – My Mummy: Children draw their mom and say one thing she does for them Flashback Talk: "What did you do with your mummy today?" Revise Aa–Ff sounds 	Rhyme printout, drawing sheets, crayons, story discussion flashcards	Visual Sorting & String Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide flashcards of tall and short animals/objects. Children sort into "Tall" and "Short" baskets. Use yarn strips to arrange from shortest to tallest. Match tall trees to tall animals. Do interactive discussion. Create a height graph display. 	Flashcards, wool strips, baskets, comparison chart paper	Washing Hands	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teach the steps of handwashing Demonstrate with soap and water Practice: each child washes hands with help Use a poster for step order Talk about when to wash hands "Hand Wash" song with actions 	Soap, water, handwashing poster, basin/bucket, song lyrics	Phonic Sound & Flashcard Visual Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Revise letter sounds ग, घ, ङ with actions Show flashcards with image + letter (ग – गलिस, घ – घंटी, ङ – अंगूठा) Children repeat the word after the teacher Play "Guess the Letter" using flashcards Encourage children to name more words starting with each letter Group the flashcards by initial sound 	Flashcards, picture cards, letter charts
