Week 10 Monday	Intro to ag/ap Word Families	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduction of short vowel /a/ (अ) using phonic chart</li> <li>Air tracing and finger tracing of "ag" and "ap" family words</li> <li>Anchor Chart: Build classroom chart "bag, tag, rag" and "cap, map, tap"</li> <li>Phonic Sound with Hindi Equivalent: /a/ = अ, /g/ = ग, /p/ = प</li> <li>Guided Sentence Formation: "This is a bag" / "I have a cap"</li> <li>Kinesthetic Learning: children mime the words they say (e.g., wear a "cap")</li> </ul>	Flashcards, anchor chart materials, phonic sound cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduction to Numbers 21–25</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Count, identify, and represent numbers 21–25</li> <li>Concrete–Pictorial–Abstract (CPA): Use cubes, then write and draw</li> <li>Hands-on Manipulatives: Form 21–25 using bundles of 10 and singles</li> <li>Visual &amp; Graphic Aid: Display number chart up to 30</li> </ul>	Cubes, sticks, number flashcards, tens/ones chart, number chart 1–30	Introduction to Daily Routine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Picture Talk: What do we do in the morning, afternoon, night?</li> <li>Visual Aids: Daily activity cards (brush, eat, sleep)</li> <li>Inquiry Qs: "What do you do after waking up?"</li> <li>Puppet Talk: "Ritu Routine" shares her day</li> <li>Word Sorting: Activity + Time (morning, night, etc.)</li> <li>Interactive Chart: Class Daily Routine Wall</li> </ul>	Flashcards, daily routine chart, puppet, word cards	Storytelling – रंग-बरिगी पुस्तक	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teacher narrates the story with a big colorful book/flashcards.</li> <li>Children name colors as they appear in story.</li> <li>Discussion: "Why are books important?"</li> <li>Identify any words with ऋ in the story.</li> <li>Draw one favorite colorful picture from story.</li> <li>End with recap: "Books give us joy."</li> </ul>	Storybook, flashcards, crayons, chart paper
Week 10 Tuesday	Guided Reading + Story Retelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Guided Reading of simple story like "The Rag on the Mat"</li> <li>Use props or puppets to retell the story</li> <li>Matching Words to Pictures: Match "bag" to picture of bag, etc.</li> <li>Visual–Motor Coordination: draw &amp; write word family in booklet</li> <li>Interactive Flashcard Drill: "Find the cap!" when word is spoken</li> </ul>	Picture books, story puppets, printed word/picture cards, mini booklets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduction to Numbers 26–30</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Extend number knowledge to 30</li> <li>Place Value with Bundles: Represent 26–30 using tens and ones</li> <li>Pair Work: One student builds number; partner reads and writes it</li> <li>Worksheet Work: Fill Missing Numbers chart from 21–30</li> </ul>	Ice-cream sticks, rubber bands, worksheet printouts, number cards	Routine Sorting & Order	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sorting Game: Put activities in correct order</li> <li>Role Play: Act out daily tasks (waking, brushing, dressing, school)</li> <li>Sensory: Match items by routine (toothbrush, spoon, bottle)</li> <li>Word Sorting: Arrange time words in sequence</li> <li>Kinesthetic: Jump to the picture of the called activity</li> <li>Workbook Page / Routine Strip</li> </ul>	Real items, cards, timeline strip, word cards, worksheet	Introduction of Letter ऋ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teacher writes ऋ on board; demonstrate stroke order.</li> <li>Children practice air-tracing with fingers.</li> <li>Use sand tray writing: say "ऋ" while tracing.</li> <li>Show flashcards: ऋष, ऋतु, ऋण.</li> <li>Repeat aloud with clapping rhythm: ऋ – वृक्ष, ऋषि.</li> <li>End with group chorus.</li> </ul>	Whiteboard, sand tray, flashcards, chalks
Week 10 Wednesday	Build-a-Word + Hop the Word Game	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CVC Word Building: Use tiles to create new ag/ap words</li> <li>Game-Based Learning: "Hop the Word" – jump on ag/ap word mats</li> <li>Rhythmic Repetition: sing "bag, tag, rag..." song with body taps</li> <li>Sound Discrimination Game: Is it ag or ap? Sort it!</li> <li>Kinesthetic Learning: children hop while spelling words aloud</li> </ul>	Word tiles, floor cutouts, rhythm song, sorting trays	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Number Names 1–5 (Revision)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Recall and spell number names 1–5</li> <li>Visual &amp; Graphic Aid: Match numeral to word cards</li> <li>Learning Through Play: Number Name Puzzle Race – Arrange scrambled letter tiles</li> <li>Dice Addition Game: Roll and write number name of total</li> </ul>	Number word cards, puzzles, dice, whiteboard, flashcards	Rhyme Recap (Betty or Head)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sing "My Head" or "Betty's Hat" – relate to daily use (washing hair, wearing cap)</li> <li>Game-Based Learning: "What Comes Next?" movement game</li> <li>Story Time: "Rina's Busy Day" – discuss timing of events</li> <li>Word Sorting: Rearranged routine phrases</li> <li>Visual Chart: Draw and label one's day</li> <li>Sensory Bag: Feel and match daily tools</li> </ul>	Rhyme chart, storybook, activity cutouts, chart, sensory items	Worksheet Practice – ऋ शब्द	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Worksheet with tracing lines for ऋ.</li> <li>Children trace and write ऋ in words: वृक्ष, ऋषि, ऋण.</li> <li>Teacher monitors pencil grip and stroke order.</li> <li>Peer checking: children swap worksheets and correct.</li> <li>Coloring activity: color a tree labeled वृक्ष.</li> <li>Stick worksheets on "ऋ शब्द wall."</li> </ul>	Worksheets, pencils, crayons, chart board
