Children repeat line by line, using actions (elephant trunk, monkey jump, dog bark). Show animal toys/flashcards while reciting. Small group performance of poem. Discussion: animals we see daily vs. wild animals. End with group recitation. 	Poem sheet, animal flashcards/toys, mic prop
Week 11 Tuesday	Story & Matching	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Guided Reading of story: “The Happy Man” (man, pan, can words) Story Retelling using puppets or stick figures Matching Game: words to pictures (e.g., jam–jar, dad–tie) Sound Discrimination Game: Is it an/am/ad? Put in the correct jar Visual–Motor Coordination: draw pictures of 3 words and label them 	Storybooks, puppets, picture cards, matching templates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reinforcing Numbers 36–40 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Extend to 40 with emphasis on grouping (3 bundles + extra) Place Value with Bundles: Build each number with tens and ones Pair Work: Build–Write–Read numbers in pairs Worksheet Work: Fill Missing Numbers (31–40) 	Bundled sticks, place value mats, worksheet printouts, number chart	Sensory & Sorting Fun	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sensory Game: Feel items – soft, rough, warm – describe with feeling Sorting Game: Match event cards to emotions (e.g., birthday – happy) Word Sorting: Opposites – happy/sad, angry/calm Visual Aids: Emoji chart Kinesthetic Game: Freeze Dance – stop and pose emotion Interactive Poster: “My Mood Today” 	Textured items, emoji cards, event flashcards, music, poster board	Introduction of Letter ए	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show large flashcard of ए. Teacher says words: कैला, मेला, नेता – highlight ए sound. Children repeat words in chorus, then individually. Air writing & finger tracing of ए in sand/sooji tray. Teacher demonstrates correct stroke on board. Children practice writing on slates. 	Flashcards, chart, sand tray/sooji tray, slates, chalk
Week 11 Wednesday	CVC Building & Hop the Word Game	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CVC Word Building Station: build “can”, “jam”, “dad” using tiles Hop the Word: jump on the correct word mat as the teacher calls it out Phonics Dice Game: roll consonants + “an”, “am”, “ad” to form words Rhythmic Repetition: chant word families while clapping 	Letter tiles, dice, floor word cards, music beats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Before, After, Between (31–40) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Find numbers before, after, and between in 31–40 range Visual & Graphic Aid: Use number strip and arrows to show position Movement–Based Math: Number Line Hop – hop to numbers before/after/between on floor line Dice Addition Game: Roll two dice, identify number between results 	Number line mat, number strip (31–40), dice, before–after flashcards	Action Rhyme – “How Do I Feel?”	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teach custom action rhyme (e.g., “If I’m angry, I stomp my feet...”) Word Game: Rearrange rhyme lines in order Story Time: “Maya’s Mixed-Up Day” – spot feelings Puppet Recap: Fuzzy reappears with new emotions Visual–Motor: Trace emoji faces Creative Craft: Emoji Emotion Stick Puppets 	Rhyme chart, storybook, puppet, emoji outlines, craft sticks	Reading Aloud ए Words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teacher models reading “मेला, कैला”. Children repeat in chorus, then individually. Group reading in pairs – each child reads a word. Quick quiz: teacher shows picture, child says ए–word. Write 2–3 ए words on board; children copy. Add ए–words to class Word Basket. 	Word basket chart, board, chalk, picture cards
