Kinesthetic Learning: Object basket sorting game with 'a/an' baskets 	Picture books, anchor chart, flashcards, real object toys, two sorting baskets labeled "a" and "an"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduction to Number Bonds (1–5) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Understand how smaller numbers combine to make a bigger number (e.g., $2 + 3 = 5$) Concrete–Pictorial–Abstract (CPA): Use counters to show multiple combinations for numbers 1 to 5 Pair Work: Each pair builds and records ways to make a number Visual Aid: Number bond circle chart 	Counters, two-color chips, number bond circle chart, flashcards	Introduction to Likes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Picture Talk: Favourite food, toys, colours, animals Inquiry Qs: "What do you like to eat/play with?" Puppet Talk: "Liky the Lion" shares his likes Word Sorting: Match item with category (fruit, toy, animal) Kinesthetic: Run to your favourite item picture Chart: Class Favourite Graph 	Picture flashcards, puppet, sorting cards, chart paper, glue	Storytelling – दयालु डाकिया	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teacher narrates story दयालु डाकिया with props (cap, bag, letters). Show picture cards of postman delivering letters. Discuss how the postman helps people every day. Highlight 2–3 words with ऐ during story. Ask children: "How can we be kind like the postman?" End with short group recap of story. 	Storybook, postman cap, bag, letter cutouts, picture cards
Week 12 Tuesday	A/an Sorting & Usage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Word Puzzle: Match picture + article (a/an) pieces together Build-a-Word Station: Create noun phrases like "an egg," "a pencil" Guided Sentence Formation: Oral and written use of a/an in context Visual-Motor Coordination: Draw and label items using "a" or "an" Hop the Word: Jump on mats labeled with "a" or "an" based on teacher's call 	Puzzle cards, word cards, writing sheets, shape mats labeled "a" and "an", crayons, pencils	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Number Bonds for 6–10 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Extend number bond concept for numbers 6 to 10 Hands-on Manipulatives: Use blocks or connecting cubes to break numbers Learning Through Play: "Build and Break" – Create a number and break into 2 parts Worksheet Work: Begin Ways to Make Numbers worksheet 	Building blocks, number cards, connecting cubes, worksheet printouts	My Favourite Colour & Food	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Colour Walk: Find something of your favourite colour Sensory Game: Guess favourite food items by smell (apple, banana, mint) Sorting Game: Group by "like" vs. "don't like" Word Sorting: Colour/food names in buckets Craft: My Favourite Colour Hat Storytime: "Tara's Taste Day" 	Colour items, smell jars, paper hats, glue, storybook, sorting mats	Introduction of ऐ Sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce ऐ sound with repetition (ऐ – ऐनक, बैल, नौना). Flashcards with ऐ pictures shown quickly; children say aloud. Clap drill: 2 claps for short vowel words, 3 claps for long vowel words. Write ऐ on the board; children practice air writing. Group chant: "ऐ ऐ ऐ – ऐनक, ऐ बैल." Add words to Word Basket chart. 	Flashcards, chart paper, board, marker, basket chart
Week 12 Wednesday	Application Through Games	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phonics Dice Game: Roll image dice and decide a/an Game-Based Learning: "A or An" Bingo Sound Discrimination Game: Identify initial sounds and apply article Matching Words to Pictures: Clip activity with a/an tags Story Retelling: Fill-in-the-blank with correct article 	Phonics dice, bingo cards, sound charts, flashcards, printed mini story books with missing articles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dice Game – Make a Number 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Reinforce number bonds through gameplay Dice Addition Game: Roll 2 dice and combine numbers, then list possible bond combinations for that total Group Task: Create a "Bond Board" – children add examples to a group chart 	Dice, number bond board/chart, markers, small whiteboards	Toys & Rhymes I Like	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rhyme Time: Each child sings or selects a favourite rhyme Puppet Show: "Toto and His Toy Chest" – favourite toys story Word Sorting: Match toy names to images Creative Craft: Draw and label your favourite toy Game-Based: "Find the Toy You Like" hunt Kinesthetic: Dance to rhyme choices 	Toy visuals, puppet, crayons, worksheet, music player, toy props	Worksheet Practice – ऐ शब्द	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Worksheet: trace and write ऐ letters. Circle all ऐ words from a mixed list. Match pictures to words (ऐनक glasses, बैल bull). Pair activity: children help each other complete worksheets. Teacher checks pencil grip & formation. Display worksheets on class board. 	Worksheets, pencils, crayons, picture cards, board
