Week 17 Monday	Introduction to Sentence Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Guided Reading with Picture Books – Read aloud simple 2–3 word sentences from illustrated books Anchor Chart – Display common CVC-based sight word sentences like “I see a cat.” Word Puzzle – Match sentence halves with pictures Visual-Motor Coordination – Trace short sentences with fingers Kinesthetic Activity – Walk to the object read aloud 	Picture books, anchor chart, printed sentence cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduction to Same and Different 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Identify similar and different objects based on size, color, shape, or function CPA Method: Show real objects Picture sorting Abstract sorting using symbols Kinesthetic Learning: “Jump to the Box” – children move to either ‘same’ or ‘different’ bins based on item held up Visual & Graphic Aid: Use flashcards for sorting by attribute 	Real objects (fruits, toys), sorting boxes, flashcards, whiteboard	Introduction to Community Helpers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Picture Talk: Identify helpers – doctor, postman, fireman, teacher, etc. Puppet Talk: “Helper Hari” introduces different professions Inquiry-Based Qs: “Who helps us stay healthy?” Word Sorting: Match helper to their job Kinesthetic: Mimic helper actions (sweep, write, drive) Chart: Helper of the Day Wall 	Helper flashcards, puppet, sorting cards, chart paper	Poem Recitation – Nature Poem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teacher recites the Nature Poem with hand actions (leaves waving, rain falling, sun shining). Children repeat lines in chorus with actions. Emphasize vowel sounds inside the poem words. Learning Activity: Group recitation with claps for rhythm. Discuss the theme: How nature helps us daily. Moral recap: Respect nature. 	Poem chart, flashcards, nature picture cards
Week 17 Tuesday	Word and Picture Matching	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Matching Words to Pictures – Match full short sentences to relevant visuals Flashcard Drills – Read and hold up matching sentence cards Sentence Formation – Use sight words and CVC words to form complete sentences Phonics Dice Game – Roll and build a sentence Story Retelling – Reconstruct yesterday’s story using key phrases 	Flashcards, dice, image cards, sentence strips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sorting by Shape and Size 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Sort items logically using shape and size characteristics Hands-on Manipulatives: Use shape cut-outs and blocks Pair Work: Partner sorting activity with ‘Shape Bags’ Learning Through Play: “Shape Sort Dash” – run to the correct group 	Shape cut-outs, baskets, labels, hula hoops, colored mats	Focus on Fireman + Rhyme	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rhyme Time: “Ten Little Firemen” with actions Role Play: Act out a fire emergency with water spray bottle, helmet, and whistle Word Sorting: Fireman tools – ladder, hose, boots Sensory Station: Feel and guess – hose, rubber boot, sponge Creative Craft: Make a fire hat Chart Display: Fire Safety Tips 	Fireman props, rhyme sheet, rubber items, fire hat template, poster	Flashcard Challenge (अ-अः Revision)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Display flashcards for each vowel (अ-अः). Children identify and pronounce with picture cues (अ – अनाट, आ – आम, इ – इमली). Learning Activity: Flashcard game – children pick one, say the sound, and act it out (eat आम, flap like a crow, etc.). Pair drill – one child shows card, partner answers. Quick oral quiz: teacher says word, students guess tating vowel. Recap in chorus. 	Flashcards, picture props
Week 17 Wednesday	Comprehension & Sound Games	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sound Discrimination Game – Pick correct sentence based on initial sound Build-a-Word Station – Build CVC words and use in a sentence Photo Hunt – Find classroom items and label them in sentences Rhythmic Repetition – Clap and repeat “I see a __” sentences Hop the Word – Hop on each word of a sentence laid on floor 	Printed floor words, word-building tools, photos	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sorting by Color and Texture 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Focus on similarities/ differences in color and feel Group Task: Sensory sorting using touch & color trays Kinesthetic Learning: “Texture Trail” – Walk barefoot on soft, rough, smooth mats and sort the matching cards Visual Aid: Color-coded chart for grouping 	Color counters, textured fabric pieces, sorting boards, floor mats	Focus on Postman + Rhyme	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rhyme Time: “The Postman” – deliver pretend letters Puppet Skit: “Pintu the Postman’s Parcel Delivery” Word Sorting: Match tools – letter, bag, stamp, cycle Role Play: Letter writing and delivery in class Craft: Make a red postbox Visual Chart: The Journey of a Letter 	Postcards, envelopes, stamp cut-outs, puppet, red chart paper	Worksheet – Mixed Vowel Test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Distribute worksheets combining tracing, writing, and matching tasks. Children trace missing vowels in series (अ, __, इ, __). Match words with correct images (आम – mango, ओस – dew). Fill-in-the-blanks using vowels. Learning Activity: Writing test – write 3 vowels from memor in notebook. Teacher checks and gives smiley stickers as motivation. 	Worksheets, pencils, crayons
