Learning Activity: Sorting transport pictures into Land, Water, Air on board. Moral recap: Use transport safely. Quick drawing – children sketch their favorite vehicle. Colored counters, texture cards, blindfolds, sensory mats	Rhyme – The Wonderful World of Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rhyme Time: Sing "The Wonderful World of Animals" with movements Puppet Recap: Safari animal quiz by "Ranger Rhino" Word Sorting: Match line from rhyme to animal Creative Craft: Make a jungle headband Chart Activity: Favourite Safari Animal Tally Visual-Motor: Colour the jungle scene 	Rhyme lyrics, puppet, craft paper, animal stickers, crayons	Reading & Oral Drill – क्ष Words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show flashcards with क्ष words: क्षमा, लक्षय, शक्षक, रक्षक. Choral reading (whole class repeats together). Individual oral drill – each child says one क्ष word. Learning Activity: Word-building game – teacher says "क्ष" sound, students complete with a word. Quick oral quiz – "Say one word with क्ष." Highlight use in short sentences: शक्षक हमें पढ़ाते हैं। 	Word flashcards, picture cards, board
