Week 19 Monday	Introduction to 'ip' family	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce the word family 'ip' through anchor chart and sound blending.</li> <li>Read aloud story with 'ip' words using picture books.</li> <li>Use Interactive Flashcard Drills with 'ip' words.</li> <li>Sing-along Phonics Song: Short Vowel /i/.</li> <li>Kinesthetic Learning: Hop to the 'ip' word.</li> </ul>	Flashcards, Anchor Chart, Picture Book	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduction to Addition</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Understand the concept of combining two groups.</li> <li>Concrete-Pictorial-Abstract (CPA): Use animal counters to show addition.</li> <li>Kinesthetic Learning: Students physically join groups of children (e.g., 2 lions + 3 tigers = 5 animals).</li> <li>Movement-Based Math: Jump to addition answers on floor mats.</li> </ul>	Animal toys, floor number line, mats, flashcards	Introduction to Uniqueness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Picture Talk: Show animals with special traits (giraffe-long neck, elephant-trunk)</li> <li>Puppet Talk: "Zara the Zookeeper" introduces the unique zoo animals</li> <li>Inquiry Qs: "Who can fly? Who can roar?"</li> <li>Word Sorting: Match animal to its special feature</li> <li>Kinesthetic: Walk like unique animals</li> <li>Chart: "What's Special About Me?"</li> </ul>	Animal flashcards, puppet, matching cards, feature chart	Poem Introduction – मकूल बस	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teacher recites poem "मकूल बस" with actions (children mimic a moving bus).</li> <li>Students repeat line by line in chorus.</li> <li>Discuss real-life connection: How they travel to school.</li> <li>Learning Activity: Group action song – children pretend to board a bus together.</li> <li>Explain safety rules while traveling in bus.</li> <li>Draw/color a simple bus in notebooks.</li> </ul>	Poem chart, bus picture, crayons
Week 19 Tuesday	Practice with 'ip' words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Build-a-Word Station: Create 'ip' words with letter tiles.</li> <li>Word Puzzle Game: Match 'ip' words to pictures.</li> <li>Rhythmic Repetition: Chant 'ip' words.</li> <li>Guided Sentence Formation using 'ip' words.</li> <li>Visual-Motor Coordination: Trace and write 'ip' words.</li> </ul>	Word tiles, Worksheets, Picture Cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Addition with Objects</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Reinforce addition using real objects.</li> <li>Hands-on Manipulatives: Count and add with beads and animal cards.</li> <li>Learning Through Play: "Animal Match" – match addition expressions to correct animal pictures.</li> <li>Pair Work: Create and solve problems with a partner using object sets.</li> </ul>	Animal cards, beads, bowls, worksheet	Exploring Bird Features	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rhyme Time: "Little Birdie" with wing-flap actions</li> <li>Sorting Game: Who has feathers? Who doesn't?</li> <li>Word Sorting: Bird features (feather, beak, wings)</li> <li>Sensory Game: Feel real feathers and soft textures</li> <li>Visual-Motor: Draw and colour your favourite bird</li> <li>Chart: Flying vs. Non-Flying Animals</li> </ul>	Rhyme sheet, feathers, sorting cards, drawing sheet, chart paper	Letter Introduction – "तृ"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show तृ on flashcard and chart, explain त + र combination.</li> <li>Air-tracing and sand tray writing practice.</li> <li>Teacher models correct stroke order on board.</li> <li>Learning Activity: Students clap when तृ is heard in words.</li> <li>Introduce तृ words: मतिर, पातर, पतर.</li> <li>Children repeat aloud with rhythm.</li> </ul>	Flashcards, sand tray, chalk/board
Week 19 Wednesday	Introduction to 'ig' family	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce the word family 'ig' with phonics dice game.</li> <li>Story Retelling using 'ig' words.</li> <li>Sound Discrimination Game: Sort 'ip' vs 'ig'.</li> <li>Hop the Word: Physical activity jumping on 'ig' words.</li> </ul>	Dice, Word Cards, Activity Sheet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Addition Using Number Line</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Learn to add by jumping on the number line.</li> <li>Number Line Hop: Use floor number line for kinesthetic addition.</li> <li>Visual &amp; Graphic Aid: Use printed number lines to solve problems.</li> <li>Group Activity: Solve task cards with number line questions.</li> </ul>	Printed and floor number lines, dice, task cards	Special Animal Abilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Storytime: "Rani the Rhino Who Could Dance"</li> <li>Role Play: Act out unique movements – slither, hop, climb, swim</li> <li>Word Sorting: Match movement to animal (slither-snake)</li> <li>Puppet Quiz: "Guess Who Has This Talent?"</li> <li>Game-Based: "Animal Ability Match" flashcard game</li> <li>Craft: Make an animal footprint trail</li> </ul>	Storybook, animal movement cards, puppet, footprint stamps, glue	Word Building & Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use picture cards to teach तृ words (मतिर – friend, पातर – vessel).</li> <li>Group reading: Children read after teacher in chorus.</li> <li>Short sentences practice (मतिर अच्छा है पतर आया है!).</li> <li>Learning Activity: "Letter Train" game – children hold flashcards and form तृ words (मि + तृ).</li> <li>Individual practice: Each child reads one तृ word.</li> <li>Teacher encourages peer correction.</li> </ul>	Word flashcards, picture cards
