Week 2 Monday	Colours in Nature – Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Story-Based Sight Word Learning using natural objects (“This is a leaf”)</li> <li>• Phonics Introduction: Short vowels /a/, /e/, /i/ with color words (e.g., red, big, sun)</li> <li>• Air &amp; Finger Tracing for beginning sounds</li> <li>• Anchor Chart: Colors &amp; vowel sounds with images (apple = /a/, egg = /e/)</li> <li>• Rhythmic Repetition: Color chant with vowel emphasis</li> <li>• Kinesthetic Learning: Jump to colored mats when a vowel or color is called</li> </ul>	Sight word flashcards, colored mats, phonics anchor chart	• Introduction to Size Comparison	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Concrete-Pictorial-Abstract (CPA): Show real classroom items in pairs (e.g., pencil vs. marker)</li> <li>• Movement-Based Math: Students compare hand spans or foot lengths with a buddy</li> <li>• Visual &amp; Graphic Aid: Display “Big vs Small” and “Short vs Long” chart</li> </ul>	Real classroom objects, size comparison chart, cutouts of different-sized items	Introduction to Shapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Picture-based discussion: show nature objects with shapes and colours (leaves, sun, rainbow)</li> <li>• Use visual aids to introduce basic shapes and colours</li> <li>• Inquiry Qs: “What colours can we see in flowers?”</li> <li>• Kinesthetic activity: children form shapes using body poses</li> <li>• Chart activity: Match shape flashcards to natural items</li> <li>• Sensory exploration: Feel texture of leaves, stones</li> </ul>	Flashcards, shape chart, real objects, picture book	Phonic Sound Drill & Oral Recap	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Revise all स्वर (अ-अं) orally with chorus repetition.</li> <li>• Children repeat individually to check clarity.</li> <li>• Use rhythm claps: 1 clap for अ, 2 for अं, etc.</li> <li>• Mirror practice – observe mouth shapes while pronouncing.</li> <li>• Quick oral quiz: teacher says word, child identifies first स्वर.</li> <li>• Group recitation of स्वर chart.</li> </ul>	Flashcards, mirror, स्वर chart, clapping cues
Week 2 Tuesday	Colour and Object Matching	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Matching Game: Match color word cards to objects</li> <li>• Interactive Flashcard Drills: Identify initial sounds in color names (e.g., /r/ for red, /g/ for green)</li> <li>• Guided Reading with Picture Books showing nature scenes with color labels</li> <li>• Sound Discrimination Game: Identify color starting with vowel vs consonant</li> <li>• Photo Hunt with Sight Words: Spot colored items in the classroom and label them</li> </ul>	Picture books, color-object cards, photo labels, flashcards	• Long, Longer, Longest	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hands-on Manipulatives: Use ribbon strips, yarn, and sticks to form size sets</li> <li>• Measurement with Non-Standard Units: Use paper clips to measure items and compare</li> <li>• Pair Work: Students arrange objects by length and label them</li> </ul>	Ribbon/yarn, ice cream sticks, paper clips, size labels	Shape Hunt in Environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Field Walk: “Find shapes around school” (windows, wheels, bricks)</li> <li>• Sensory Exploration: Touch &amp; describe collected objects</li> <li>• Sorting Game: Group findings by shape</li> <li>• Role Play: Shape Detectives with magnifying glasses</li> <li>• Interactive Chart: Stick photos of found items</li> <li>• Visual-Motor: Trace shapes seen on walk</li> </ul>	Camera/photo printouts, glue, shape chart, worksheet	Worksheet Practice – Missing Letters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Distribute worksheet with incomplete स्वर sequence (अ, __, इ, __, उ ...).</li> <li>• Children fill missing letters independently.</li> <li>• Teacher walks around correcting pencil grip.</li> <li>• Pair activity: check each other’s sheets.</li> <li>• Group discussion of answers on board.</li> <li>• Stick completed worksheets on “स्वर Wall.”</li> </ul>	Worksheets, pencils, crayons, wall chart
Week 2 Wednesday	Sight Word + Short Vowel Blending	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CVC Word Building (with relevant vowels: sun, red, bud)</li> <li>• Guided Sentence Formation: “This is a ___” using color and object</li> <li>• Word Puzzle: Rearranging letters of color words</li> <li>• Sing-Along Phonics: “Red, Red, What Do You See?”</li> <li>• Visual-Motor Coordination: Trace and color vowel-starting objects</li> </ul>	Word puzzle cards, letter tiles, crayons, tracing sheets	• Small, Medium, Large	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Story-based Problem Solving: “The Three Bears” – Match chairs, bowls, and beds to characters</li> <li>• Learning Through Play: Small-Medium-Large sorting trays</li> <li>• Role Play: Match object to the right character (e.g., baby bear uses small spoon)</li> </ul>	Bear story props, object sets in 3 sizes, sorting trays, printable character tags	Sorting & Matching Shapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sorting Cards: Match shape cutouts to real-world items</li> <li>• Puppet Talk: “Circle the Explorer” introduces sorting rules</li> <li>• Game-Based Learning: Shape treasure hunt in classroom</li> <li>• Word Sorting: Arrange shape word cards</li> <li>• Kinesthetic Activity: Jump to the called-out shape mat</li> <li>• Workbook Page: Shape tracing &amp; matching</li> </ul>	Shape cut-outs, puppet, treasure clues, shape mats, workbook	Storytelling – अलग-अलग आकार	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Narrate story अलग अलग आकार with shape cards (circle, square, triangle).</li> <li>• Highlight words starting with अ/आ/इ (अनार, आम, इमली).</li> <li>• Ask children to identify which स्वर they hear.</li> <li>• Show props/shapes in real objects (ball = गोल, book = चौकोर).</li> <li>• Short drawing activity : draw one shape and label with स्वर word.</li> <li>• End with recap chant of अ-इ.</li> </ul>	Storybook, shape flashcards, real objects (ball, box), drawing sheets, crayons
