"Do elephants eat meat?"</li> <li>Word Sorting: Match animal-food cards</li> <li>Kinesthetic Game: Act out eating styles (chew, bite, lick)</li> <li>Chart: Herbivore-Carnivore-Omnivore Wall</li> </ul>	Animal and food flashcards, puppet, sorting mats, chart paper	Story: ज्ञान की रेल	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Narrate story "ज्ञान की रेल" with big picture cards/flashcards (train, books, children learning).</li> <li>Emphasize ज्ञ words (ज्ञान, वज्रापन, वज्रान).</li> <li>Children repeat ज्ञ words after the teacher.</li> <li>Story-based discussion: "ज्ञान से हमें क्या मलिता है?"</li> <li>Learning Activity: Children form a "ज्ञान रेल" line in class, each child saying one ज्ञ word aloud.</li> <li>Drawing: Students draw a small रेलगाड़ी and write one ज्ञ word in each coach.</li> </ul>	Story chart, flashcards, crayons, drawing sheet
Week 20 Tuesday	Focus: id	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CVC Word Building: Make words like kid, lid, rid</li> <li>Matching Words to Pictures – id set</li> <li>Build-a-Word Station using magnetic letters</li> <li>Phonics Dice Game – Roll and build -id words</li> <li>Kinesthetic tracing of words in air</li> <li>Sound Discrimination Game: id vs ed</li> </ul>	Flashcards, dice, letter tiles, charts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Solving with Pictures</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Solve addition story problems using visual clues.</li> <li>Visual &amp; Graphic Aid: Picture-based story problems (e.g., 2 cats join 3 dogs).</li> <li>Pair Work: Partner up to solve and explain the addition stories.</li> <li>Learning Through Play: "Animal Adventure" – solve cards to move on the story map.</li> </ul>	Story cards, worksheets, pencils, game board	Exploring Pet Animal Foods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rhyme Time: Sing "I Love Little Pussy" with actions (petting, meowing)</li> <li>Role Play: Feeding a soft toy pet – milk, biscuits, bones</li> <li>Sensory Activity: Guess pet food by smell (milk powder, dry biscuits)</li> <li>Word Sorting: Pet names and their favourite foods</li> <li>Visual Chart: Pet Menu Board</li> <li>Craft: Pet Food Bowl Collage</li> </ul>	Toy pets, small cups, biscuits, milk powder (safe), cutouts, glue	Letter Practice: ज्ञ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduce अक्षर ज्ञ on board + flashcards.</li> <li>Air tracing and sand tray practice of ज्ञ.</li> <li>Phonetic drill: ज्ञा-न, वज्रा-पन, पृज्ना (repeat slowly).</li> <li>Learning Activity: Clay modeling – children form अक्षर ज्ञ using clay.</li> <li>Show 3-4 picture cards (ज्ञान – कतिब, वज्रापन – अखबार) and children repeat.</li> <li>Group chanting of ज्ञ words.</li> </ul>	Blackboard, chalk, sand tray, clay, flashcards
Week 20 Wednesday	Focus: ix	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Story Time: "Fix-It Fox" for ix family</li> <li>Visual-Motor Tracing and Finger Writing</li> <li>Interactive Flashcard Drill with ix words</li> <li>Guided Sentence Formation: "I fix a ___"</li> <li>Word Puzzles using ix family words</li> <li>Rhythmic repetition activity: ix chant</li> </ul>	Flashcards, tracing sheets, puzzles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Using Number Line</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Use number line to solve addition stories.</li> <li>Number Line Hop: Students jump forward steps based on story events.</li> <li>Movement-Based Math: Solve and jump to answers across floor grid.</li> <li>Hands-on Manipulatives: Use animal counters and dice to create own story and solve.</li> </ul>	Floor number line, dice, counters, story slips	Wild vs Domestic Food Patterns	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sorting Game: Who eats what – wild vs domestic animals</li> <li>Puppet Skit: "Milo the Monkey" shares his fruit basket</li> <li>Word Sorting: Match wild animals with fruit, grass, meat</li> <li>Kinesthetic Game: Crawl like a lion to your food</li> <li>Visual Chart: Food Pyramid of Animals</li> <li>Craft: Animal Food Platter</li> </ul>	Animal cards, food visuals, puppet, pyramid chart, cutouts	Poem & Reading: रेलगाड़ी	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teach poem "रेलगाड़ी" with actions – children move like a train and say "छुक-छुक".</li> <li>Group recitation of the rhyme in rhythm.</li> <li>Reading aloud from flashcards – ज्ञान, वज्रापन, वज्रान.</li> <li>Learning Activity: Railway track tracing worksheet – write ज्ञ on tracks.</li> <li>Word Hunt: Teacher says a word – children clap if it has ज्ञ.</li> <li>Short story link: "Train of knowledge takes us to new places."</li> </ul>	Poem chart, toy train, worksheet with tracks
