Week 22 Monday	Introduction to Sentence Construction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Introduction to sentence structure using simple nouns and verbs</li> <li>Anchor Chart – Parts of a Sentence (Subject + Verb)</li> <li>Guided Reading with Picture Books featuring simple sentences</li> <li>Story Retelling with sentence focus</li> <li>Word Family Sorting Game – identify and group similar endings</li> </ul>	Anchor chart, storybooks, sentence posters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Numbers 71–75</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Introduction to numbers 71–75 using counting objects and visual cards.</li> <li>Kinesthetic Learning: “Jump and Count” using hopscotch-style number layout.</li> <li>CPA Method: Show 7 bundles of 10 and loose ones for numbers 71–75.</li> <li>Pair Work: Count and match flashcards with the correct number.</li> </ul>	Number flashcards, counting bundles, hopscotch mat, small objects	Introduction to Farm Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Picture Talk: Identify cow, hen, goat, duck, horse, etc.</li> <li>Puppet Talk: “Farmer Fido” introduces his animals</li> <li>Inquiry Qs: “Which animal lives in a coop?”</li> <li>Word Sorting: Animal–Home cards (pen, barn, coop)</li> <li>Kinesthetic: Imitate farm animal movements</li> <li>Chart: Who Lives Where? Poster</li> </ul>	Animal flashcards, puppet, sorting cards, chart paper, movement props	Storytelling – चतुर चालक	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teacher narrates story “चतुर चालक” with expressions and props.</li> <li>Children repeat key संयुक्त अक्षर words from the story.</li> <li>Learning Activity: Role-play short parts of the story.</li> <li>Ask simple recall questions about the story.</li> <li>Teacher highlights moral: बुद्धिमानी से कठिनाई हल करना.</li> <li>End with group discussion: “अगर हम होते तो क्या करते?”</li> </ul>	Story props, flashcards
Week 22 Tuesday	Sentence Building Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CVC Word Building with sentence starters</li> <li>Interactive Flashcard Drills: form complete sentences</li> <li>Guided Sentence Formation using “These/Those”</li> <li>Phonics Dice Game – Roll and write a complete sentence</li> <li>Rhythmic Repetition: Clap the sentence parts</li> </ul>	Flashcards, dice, whiteboard, sentence strips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Numbers 76–80</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Continue number introduction with focus on place value.</li> <li>Hands-on Manipulatives: Counting beads and rods for forming numbers 76–80.</li> <li>Movement-Based Math: Number relay with teams.</li> <li>Visual &amp; Graphic Aid: Show numbers with tens and ones chart.</li> </ul>	Beads, rods, number cards, place value chart, cones for relay	Animal Sounds on the Farm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rhyme Recap: “Little Birdie” and add farm animal sound chorus</li> <li>Sensory Game: Guess the animal by its sound</li> <li>Game-Based: Animal Sound Freeze (stop when your sound plays)</li> <li>Word Sorting: Match animal–sound–picture</li> <li>Visual-Motor: Draw an animal and write its sound</li> <li>Chart: Animal Sound Wall</li> </ul>	Sound clips, speakers, rhyme sheet, sound flashcards, drawing sheets	Phonics Drill – Joint Consonants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recap of संयुक्त अक्षर (कष, त्र, ज्ञ, श्र) using big chart/board.</li> <li>Teacher pronounces, children clap &amp; repeat.</li> <li>Learning Activity: Flashcard Toss – teacher shows अक्षर, child says a word quickly.</li> <li>Oral drill with group chanting of अक्षर words.</li> <li>Picture–Word Match: identify अक्षर in picture words (ज्ञान, शर्म).</li> <li>Quick quiz: “त्रकोण में कौन-सा संयुक्त अक्षर है?”</li> </ul>	Flashcards, picture cards
Week 22 Wednesday	Visual Sentence Mapping	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Matching Words to Pictures with sentence writing</li> <li>Picture Prompt Guided Writing</li> <li>Build-a-Word Station with sentence extensions</li> <li>Hop the Word – jump to complete the next word in the sentence</li> <li>Kinesthetic Learning – act out subject-verb actions</li> </ul>	Picture cards, hop tiles, sentence word sets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ascending Order</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Topic Points: Concept of smallest to biggest.</li> <li>Concrete–Pictorial–Abstract (CPA): Arrange number blocks from 71–80.</li> <li>Learning Through Play: “Ladder of Numbers” – place correct numbers step-by-step.</li> <li>Pair Work / Group Tasks: Create ascending order tower using number cards.</li> </ul>	Number blocks, ladder cutouts, number cards, glue stick	What Do Farm Animals Eat?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sorting Game: Match animal to food (grass–cow, grain–hen)</li> <li>Puppet Skit: “Goat Gobbles Everything!” story</li> <li>Sensory Table: Touch &amp; smell animal food samples (grain, hay)</li> <li>Word Sorting: Herbivore–Omnivore categories</li> <li>Craft: Make a Feed the Animal pocket chart</li> <li>Chart: Farm Food Web</li> </ul>	Puppet, grain samples, scent jars, cutouts, pocket chart materials	Worksheet Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Distribute worksheet: tracing + fill-in-the-blanks with संयुक्त अक्षर.</li> <li>Students circle संयुक्त अक्षर in short sentences.</li> <li>Learning Activity: Buddy Reading – one reads word, partner continues.</li> <li>Match words with pictures activity.</li> <li>Teacher guides weaker students individually.</li> <li>Peer check: children exchange worksheets and read 2–3 words aloud.</li> </ul>	Worksheets, pencils, crayons
