Recite once, then children repeat in chorus. Highlight tricky sounds (ऌ/ॡ, ३/ॡ, अं) Learning Activity: Sound gestures – short (ऌ, ३) with small hand sign, long (ॡ, ॡ) with stretched sign. Discuss meaning of poem in simple words. End with 2–3 children reciting lines individually. 	Poem chart, sound flashcards

Children practice sounds aloud in chorus. Introduce minimal pairs with flashcards (बलि-बील, पुल-पूला, से-सुन). Learning Activity: Jump & Say – jump once for ऌ/ॡ, twice for ॡ/ॡ. Teacher calls words > children identify correct sound. Group discussion: "How one sound changes the meaning of the word." 	Flashcards, sound charts
