Group reading of short संयुक्त words (मतिर, प्रिया, त्याग). Cut-out अक्षर activity – arrange letters to form संयुक्त words. Pair reading: children take turns reading aloud. Add new words to Word Basket chart. Quick recap rhyme: "त्रा-त्रा-त्रा, ग्य-ग्य-ग्य." 	Word cut-outs, flashcards, basket chart, worksheets
