Students recite together in chorus, stressing cluster sounds (क्क, ब्ब, प्प, स्त). Teacher pauses at key words, children complete them aloud (fill-the-gap recitation). Students perform recitation in pairs, one child says half a line, the other completes it. Class sings rhyme again with drum/tambourine beats to reinforce rhythm. Plane diagram, A4 sheets for craft, pilot hats, boarding cards, sorting cards	Cluster Revision Drill	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teacher writes clusters (क्क, ब्ब, प्प, स्त, ज्ञ) on the board, students pronounce aloud together. Children trace clusters in the air with fingers, then write in notebooks. "Cluster Hunt": Teacher says a cluster, students quickly write one word using it. Flashcard drill: Teacher shows cluster cards, children shout words. Teacher forms two teams; each team lists as many cluster words as possible in 2 minutes. Teacher asks comprehension questions: "What did the boy do in the story?" etc. Peer dictation: In pairs, one child reads a cluster word, the other writes it down.
