Kinesthetic: “Point to...” body actions for each member Chart Making: Class count of siblings Storytelling: “My Family and I” short story 	Flashcards, photo visuals, word cards, storybook, chart paper	Poem Recitation – Tree Poem (पेड़ कवति)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teacher recites the Tree Poem with actions (show branches, fluttering leaves). Children repeat line by line with expressions. Group recitation in a circle with hand movements. Discussion: why trees are important in our life. Connect poem to daily life: “Tree is our friend.” End with moral reminder: “We must protect trees.” 	Poem chart, flashcards of trees, green props (paper leaves)

Teacher demonstrates stroke order on board. Air tracing & finger tracing of ई. Children repeat sounds in chorus. Clap rhythm drill: say ई words with claps. Add words to “Word Basket.” 	Flashcards, word basket chart, whiteboard, chalk/ marker
