Children repeat with rhythm and clap to the tune. Use flashcards of fruits (apple, mango, orange, banana, grapes). Discuss: "Which fruit do you like?" Add fruit names with अ sound to Word Basket. End with chorus recitation. 	Poem printout, fruit flashcards, toy/plastic fruits, word basket
Week 9 Tuesday	Word Family Sorting & Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Word Sorting Game: Sort mixed flashcards into 'ab' and 'at' baskets Guided Reading with Picture Books featuring word family vocabulary Word-Picture Matching: Match "cat" to cat picture, "tab" to tablet Sound Discrimination Game: "Tap if it ends in 'ab', jump if 'at'" Sing-Along Word Family Song: "A cat on a mat with a bat" 	Flashcards, baskets, mini books, sorting mats, music player	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Symbol Introduction (>, <, =) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Learn to use symbols for comparing numbers Hands-on Manipulatives: Use number cards and symbol cutouts to build equations Learning Through Play: "Gator Mouth" activity – Which side is greater? Compare अ vs आ on board (shape + sound). Children do finger tracing in air and sand tray. Practice अ with hand-on-back tracing (peer activity). Teacher writes अ on board, children repeat in notebooks. End with oral drill: अ-words chanted together. 	Flashcards, board, sand/rice tray, notebooks, pencils
Week 9 Wednesday	Build-a-Word & Game Stations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Build-a-Word Station: Use letter cards to create bat, tab, cab, etc. Phonics Dice Game: Roll the dice to form 'ab' and 'at' words Hop the Word: Jump on mats with 'ab' and 'at' words when the teacher calls them CVC Word Building: Build basic 3-letter 'ab' and 'at' words Rhythmic Repetition: Clap while saying "bat-cat-hat" and "tab-cab-jab" 	Dice, floor mats, magnetic letters, word-building templates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dice Game: Compare Two Numbers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topic Points: Reinforce comparison of two numbers using real-life math tools Dice Addition Game: Roll 2 dice, compare numbers formed Movement-Based Math: Jump toward the greater number on number line Group Task: Create "comparison cards" and quiz each other 	Dice sets, number line mat, comparison cards, reward tokens	My Head – Rhyme Action	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rhyme Time: Sing "My Head" with full-body actions Sensory Movement: Point to organ while saying its function Game-Based Learning: "Name That Sense" quiz Word Sorting: Scramble and arrange sense names Chart Activity: Complete "Senses Around Me" poster Visual-Motor: Trace & color organs 	Rhyme chart, action cards, poster chart, tracing sheet, crayons	Reading Aloud – अ Words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show picture cards: ऊन, ऊन का सूटकेट, ऊन की टोपी. Children read words loudly in chorus. Pair practice: each child reads 1 word to partner. Teacher highlights difference between short अ and long आ in words. Add आ-words to Word Basket chart. End with small group reading. 	Picture cards (wool, sweater, cap), flashcards, basket chart
